Admission Requirements

A. Application Requirements

- I. All applicants are required to submit an Archdiocese of New Orleans Catholic High Schools Application Form.

Current Catholic Elementary School Students

Must return this form to their present school by November 2009.

Current Non-Catholic Elementary School Students

Must send the following to St. Augustine High School by November 2009:

- Archdiocese Application Form
- Transcripts (5th – 8th)
- Standardized Test Results
- 1st quarter report card (current grade)

- II. All applicants must attend Application Day on January 9, 2010 @ 8am at the school.

Applicants for seventh, eighth, ninth, and tenth grades must adhere to every phases of the admission procedure which consists of the following:

- A \$20.00 application fee (non-refundable, non-transferable) (payable to the school)
- An examination
- An interview
- Orientation

B. Criteria for acceptance:

- Satisfactory grades from a previous school
- Satisfactory performance on the examination
- Positive recommendation from the previous school
- An interview between the applicant, his parents, and the admissions committee

Additional criteria:

- Seventh, Eighth, and ninth grade applicants:
 - Satisfactory performance in special summer programs
 - Final rank in class in the summer program (Based on class work and the judgment of summer teachers concerning maturity and work habits.)
- Tenth grade applicants:
 - Must have successfully completed (6) of the (23) units required by the State of Louisiana for high school graduation. Those units include the following courses:
 - English 1
 - Algebra 1
 - World Geography or World History
 - Physical education
 - Two electives (one must be a Science)
